- How many individuals live in your home, what are their dates of birth and relationship to you?
- Has there been any change to the number or status of any members in your household?
- Whom do you support financially? Do you make support payments?
- Did you pay for an attendant, childcare provider or any retirement or nursing home costs? Do you or any dependent living with you have a mental or physical infirmity or disability?
- Did your marital status change during the year?
- Did anyone in your family arrive in or leave Canada?
- Did anyone in your family pay for medical expenses this year, other than MSP? (MSP is not deductible) Did anyone in your family attend a post-secondary institution, part-time or full-time?

- 11. Did anyone in your family make donations or gifts to charities?
